This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for exemption from filing original/certified/legible/true typed copies of Annexures & copy of Aadhar card.

CRM-M-12172-2023:

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.586 dated 20.12.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 & 427 of IPC registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that injury attracting Section 307 of the IPC to injured Manpreet Singh is attributed to Akram Khan @ Akku. The only role attributed to the petitioner Lakhveer Singh @ Gagan Walia is that he had given rod blow on the right leg behind the knee of the injured.

Custody certificate has been placed on record by learned State counsel which reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last 3 months and 11 days. As per custody certificate, petitioner is involved in two more cases but he is on bail on those cases.
