The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of impugned order dated 01.02.2019 (Annexure P-5), passed by the court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala, whereby the petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed Offender in case F.I.R. No.198 dated 27.06.2015 under Sections 452/ 341/ 323/ 427/ 506/ 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Tripri - Patiala, District Patiala.

In terms of order dated 27.02.2023, the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial court and on his doing so, he was directed to be released on interim bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been admitted to interim bail by the trial court.

Since, vide separate order of even date passed in '**CRM-M-16032-2022 titled as Avijot Singh versus State of Punjab and others**', the F.I.R. No.198 dated 27.06.2015 under Sections 452/ 341/ 323/ 427/ 506/ 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Tripri - Patiala, District Patiala, has also been quashed on the basis of compromise arrived between the parties before learned Presiding Officer National Lok Adalat, vide order dated 11.12.2021 (Annexure P-4 in CRM-M-16032-2022), therefore, nothing survives in the petition and the same is disposed of, as having become infructuous.
