1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for granting recognition to the school of petitioner immediately without insisting to apply again online as the same is pending since 2019 without any legal/justifiable reason.

2. A perusal of the reply would show that it has been stated that the school authorities failed to apply online with original documents so the necessary action could not be taken.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file afresh petition after annexing the relevant documents showing as to whether the original documents were required to be submitted or even certified copy

could be allowed.

- 4. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
- 5. In case any such petition is filed, it would be incumbent upon the petitioner to file the copy of the reply filed in the present writ petition.
