On 31.05.2023, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Setting aside the judgment of acquittal recorded by the Trial Court, the respondent-accused was convicted by this Court vide order dated 24.05.2023 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and today, the case is fixed for hearing the respondent-accused on quantum of sentence.

It is informed by learned counsel for the applicant-appellant, learned counsel for the respondent-accused and respondent-accused, who is present in Court, that the matter has been settled between the parties. The respondent-accused has agreed to pay the cheque amount of ₹3,40,000/-, which the applicant-appellant is ready to accept. An amount of ₹1,00,000/- has been paid in cash today by the respondent-accused, which has been accepted by learned counsel on behalf of the applicant-appellant. Respondent-accused has undertaken to pay the balance amount of ₹2,40,000/- within one month from today.

Learned counsel for the applicant-appellant has no objection.

Adjourned to 07.07.2023 for making payment of balance amount, as per the settlement.

Today, it is informed by learned counsel for the applicant-appellant/complainant that balance amount of ₹2,40,000/- has since been

received by him from the respondent-accused and that he is satisfied with the same and the matter be disposed for having been compounded.

In view of the aforesaid statement, this application for grant of leave to appeal stands disposed of having been compounded between the parties.
