The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No. 39 dated 22.02.2023 registered under Sections 285, 336 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(9) and 27 of Arms Act (Sections 506 of IPC and 27 of Arms Act added later on) at Police Station Buria, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners contends that on the directions of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and are no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been stated that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Charanjit, submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.03.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
