HARKESH MANUJA, J.(ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner prays for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to complete the investigation and file the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.144 dated 08.05.2021, under Sections 307, 324, 341, 323, 506, 148, 149, 201 of IPC (Annexure P-1) and the cross version GD No.52 dated 11.05.2021 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Tripari District Patiala (Annexure P-2) and to add Section 307, 452 295-A IPC in the Cross Version of the above said FIR.

On 30.03.2022, the following order was passed:

“Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to complete the investigation and file the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

The limited prayer of the petitioner is to seek status report as to whether final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed or not.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice and he prays for time to file status report as above.

Adjourned to 04.05.2022.”

In pursuance thereof, learned State counsel on instruction from ASI Charan Singh, Police Station Tripari, District Patiala, submits that the investigation in the present FIR already stands concluded with the filing of final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the Illaqa Magistrate on 06.10.2022 and the matter is pending consideration upon charge for 20.03.2023. It has been informed that a cancellation report has been submitted with regard to GD No.52 dated 11.05.2021.

In view of the above, prayer made in the instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
