This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the orders dated 25.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri and order dated 04.10.2018 passed by the Principle Secretary to the Government of Haryana, Development and Panchayats Department, Haryana, vide which the appeal filed by the petitioner challenging the removal order passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.5 has pointed out that as per the case of the petitioner, the petitioner was appointed on 10.01.2016 and the said tenure has elapsed in the year 2021 itself and even thereafter fresh election has been conducted and new Sarpanch has been elected, thus, the present writ petition has been

rendered infructuous.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said facts.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, however, the liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present writ petition or to file a fresh one in case any cause survives.
