The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 10.01.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional District Judge, Chandigarh, as well as, order dated 02.09.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh and to direct the trial Court to either stay the further proceedings of the present case or in alternative the trial of the petitioners be segregated from the trial of co-accused Rajnish Kumar and Anil Dogra in in FIR No.22 dated 22.02.1994 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Darshan Singh, has submitted that the entire prosecution evidence in the matter already stands completed. Not only that, even the statement of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. has since been recorded.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any further. Hence, the same is dismissed.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, is also disposed of as such.
