On 14.03.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 22.02.2023 passed by the Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana in case No.NDPS22799 of 2022 arising out of FIR No.128 dated 20.05.2022 under Sections 21(b), 29, 61 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana whereby the non-bailable warrants against the petitioner have been issued.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of noting down of a wrong date, the petitioner was unable to appear on 02.12.2022, pursuant to which, the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Institute for the Blind, Sector 26, Chandigarh, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”.

In pursuance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has since been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in this case. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for sufficient cause.
