The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.74 dated 17.06.2021 registered under Sections 326, 324, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.03.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 02.05.2023 by way of an affidavit of Satnam Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Darshan Lal admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.03.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
