Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of the application No. CRM-522-2019 filed by the complainant/respondent on 12.12.2019 Annexure P-2 for restoration of the complaint No. NACT-11-2017 titled as Hardev Singh Vs. Gurinder Singh Rana instituted on 17.01.2017 and dismissed as withdrawn on 04.11.2019 in the Court of learned JMIC, Phillaur.

A perusal of the order dated 04.11.2019, Annexure P-1 shows that the complaint was permitted to be withdrawn based on the compromise and statement of the accused-petitioner that he will comply with the terms and conditions of the compromise and will be bound to appear before the Court for final adjudication of the case if he committed default to make payment. It was thus liberty was granted for revival of the complaint in case the accused failed to comply with the terms and conditions. When the accused-petitioner had not

adhered to the compromise, the application dated 12.12.2019, Annexure P-2, was filed wherein notice has been issued and due to non-appearance of the accused-petitioner, the conditional warrant had been issued on 17.02.2020 (Annexure P-6).

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition to enable him to raise the pleas before the trial Court at appropriate stage.

Allowed as prayed for.
