Petitioners in the present writ petition, filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeks the relief for regularizing the colony namely 'Shiv Shakti' and also sought setting aside of the various provisions of the policy dated 18.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) and the subsequent orders passed on 06.08.2019 & 02.02.2023 (Annexures P-2 & P-3, respectively).

2. Reply has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.2 & 3 wherein, in para No.6, it has been mentioned that the District Town Planner (Regulatory), GMADA has been directed by the Additional Chief Administrator, Sh. Amarinder Singh Tiwana to make a complaint with Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar to lodge an FIR under the provisions of the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995 against the promoters of the unauthorized colony within a period of two weeks. Apart from that, it has been directed that demolition of the unauthorized colony/construction shall be made after following due process of law.

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2. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed as not pressed. Keeping in view the reply filed, report be filed by the Additional Chief Administrator with the Registrar (General) of this Court within a period of two months from today that the necessary compliance has been done.
