This is an application under Section 151 CPC for withdrawing
the main petition by pre-poning the same.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the
petitioner had filed a petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari
for quashing the order dated 20.06.1994 (Annexure P-3), 15.03.1995
(Annexure P-4), and order dated 15.04.1996 (Annexure P-5) and has
submitted that the main writ petition was admitted and the petitioner has,
during the pendency of the present petition, died and the son of the
petitioner does not want to pursue the case and wishes to withdraw the same
with liberty to pursue appropriate remedy before the concerned authorities.

The application is supported by an affidavit of the applicant.

Learned State counsel has stated that she has no objection in case the main petition is preponed to today itself as the applicant only wants to withdraw the main petition.

In view of the above, the main petition is preponed to today and is taken on Board today itself for hearing and the application i.e., CM-4292-CWP-2023 is allowed and the main petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to pursue the case before the revenue authorities.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the applicant to pursue the case before the revenue authorities.
