AVNEESH JHINGAN , J.(Oral)

1. This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 54 dated 9.6.2018 on the basis of compromise.
2. Learned State Counsel points out that Section 307 IPC was invoked in the FIR as the doctor opined that two injuries inflicted were dangerous to life.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing for some time and realizing that in view of the decision of the Supreme Court in **State of Madhya Pradesh vs. Laxmi Narayan and others, 2019(2), RCR (Criminal) 225**, petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise involving Section 307 IPC is not maintainable, seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
4. Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
5. Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
