The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 11.01.2021 (Annexure P-3).

On issuance of notice of motion, learned State counsel has filed the status report dated 11.05.2021, wherein the following averments have been made:-

“During inquiry, nothing has come forward regarding committing cheating the applicant at the hands of Komalpreet Kaur etc. From the inquiry, the matter is found to be of give and take money between the parties and due to the case falls under the definition of civil matter, the applicant Ravinder Singh has been instructed to pursue his case in the Court. Due to the reasons mentioned above, no action is required to be taken by the local police on the enclosed applications. Therefore, it is recommended that the applications be consigned to the record. Accordingly, the matter was seen and filed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur on 05.05.2021.”

Since the matter has already been inquired into and it has been found that the

dispute is of civil nature, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
