1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with the following prayer:-

“(i) A direction to respondents issuing to respondents to investigate and decide the complaint moved by Resham Singh s/o Narinder Singh bering no.484-5AP/PS-NRI-ASR/29.11.2021 in time bound manner as duly mentioned in the petition, may kindly be issued.

(ii) Issue of such other appropriate order as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of Justice, Equity and Good Conscience.

(iii) Exempt the petitioner from filing the certified copies of Annexures P-1 to Annexure P-4.”

2. Response to the petition has been filed by way of affidavit dated 02.11.2022 by way of Sundeep Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, NRI, Amritsar, wherein the stand of the respondent is as under:-

6. That it is humbly submitted that on the basis of detailed enquiry conducted, it is revealed that the complainant Rasham Singh Husband of Jyoti (present petitioner) is residing abroad Italy since 2009 and that Narinder Singh @ Rinku brother of complainant and his wife Sarabjit Kaur are residing at village Gharinda. Also it transpired that Ranjit Kaur wife of Gurminder Singh the sister of the complainant are residing at street no. 1 Sher Shah Suri rual Chheharta, Amritsar.

7. That it is humbly submitted that during course of enquiry carried out in the present complaint it is found to be alleged that the present petitioner Jyoti Kaur now residing at her parental home while she left her matrimonial heme had locked her room wherein her valueables were kept.

8. That it is humbly submitted that during the course of enquiry the present petitioner Jyoti failed to produce any proof or any other evidence regarding the theft of her valuables.

9. That it is humbly submitted that during the course of enquiry it was found that Jyoti Kaur (present petitioner) picked her valutaties from her matrimonial home and went to abroad (Italy) now.

10. That it is humbly submitted that the during the enquiry no evidence is found regarding the theft of valuables of the present petitioner Jyoti and it was found that there is a family dispute between the both parties. Accordingly Insp. Kamalmeet Singh SHO PS NRI Amritsar recommended to file the complaint no. 484-5AP/PS-NRI-ASR/29.11.2021 (UID NO. 2196553) on merit.”
