1. Present transfer application, under Section 24 CPC, has been filed by the petitioner-wife, for seeking transfer of the petition bearing No. HMA/705/2017, filed by respondent-husband, under Section 13 (1) (ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, titled as “Gaurav Chahal Vs. Smt. Kuntal Beniwal”, presently pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Family Court, Ambala, to any Court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.
