The main grouse of the petitioners is that they have not been given the benefit of question No.2 (Set-C) in the revised final answer key issued on 27/28.11.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already made various representations to the concerned authority, which are still pending consideration.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners will file a comprehensive/consolidated representation before respondent No.3 for redressal of their grievance within a period of 15 days from today and that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the same.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. R.S.Budhwar, Addl. A. G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the comprehensive representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioners during the course of hearing, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a comprehensive/consolidated representation before respondent No.3 within 15 days from today. On doing so, respondent No.3 shall decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks thereafter.
