By means of this writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the respondent No.2, who delegated the powers of Secretary to Joint Secretary in order to host the future fest activities without his consent and further for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to not to delegate the power of Secretary to Joint Secretary.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the petitioner in order to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as not pressed.
