Learned counsel for the appellant-plaintiff submits that in the present case, the appellant-plaintiff remained on the post of Peon during the entire service career but has not been given any benefit under the Assured Career Progression Scheme only on the ground that there was a punishment imposed upon him reverting him to the basic pay scale whereas, once the appellant-plaintiff had required number of years of service in his credit in a particular cadre and he was entitled for promotion on the basis of the rules governing the service, the benefit of ACP could not have been withheld for all times to come, if the promotion to the higher cadre has not been extended.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that an appropriate consideration will be given to the claim of the appellant-plaintiff for the grant of benefit of ACP by taking into consideration all the terms and conditions of the Assured Career Progression Scheme and in case it is found

that the appellant-plaintiff is entitled for the said benefit, the same will be extended to him within a period of two months from the due date along with arrears.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present regular second appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

It may be noticed that consideration to the claim of the appellant-plaintiff be extended without being influenced by the judgments and decrees of the Courts below.
