The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing of the order dated 10.03.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.3-Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), U.T. Chandigarh and to direct respondent No.2 to release the amount of Rs. 70 lakhs with interest @ 12%.

The present case was listed on 13.05.2019 when certain queries were raised. Counsel for the petitioner sought time to address on the same. The case was adjourned on as many as 12 occasions on request of the petitioner, however, an adjournment slip has been circulated again and no one even appeared on behalf of the petitioner. The same is accordingly declined, it seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
