“On 04.07.2022, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the present writ petition is to issue a writ of Mandamus directing respondent no.3 to refer the matter to the Land Acquisition Tribunal. The petitioner claims that his land has been acquired in exercise of the powers under the Punjab Town Improvement Act, 1922 and an application submitted under Section 18 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 has not been forwarded to the Tribunal.

Notice of motion.

At the request of the Court, Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1 to 3 and prays for some time.

Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Addl.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from the concerned official, submits that the application submitted by the petitioner shall be decided or forwarded to the Tribunal within a week, from today.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the order dated 06.07.2022 is recalled.
