Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to take appropriate action on the complaint diary No.155 Dasti dated 25.12.2020 moved by the petitioner to respondent No.6 and complaint dated 30.12.2020 to respondent No.4 and complaint diary No.026270 dated 19.03.2021 moved by the petitioner against respondents No.7 and 8 and with a further prayer to register an FIR.

Notice was issued and the State was directed to file reply. In pursuance to the same, status report by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Hisar has been filed.

Learned State counsel has submitted that complaints filed as contended by the petitioner have been duly enquired into. He submits that the enquiry was marked to Economic Cell for verification of facts and necessary legal action. He submits that detailed reply has been filed mentioning therein that in the complaints filed, a detailed enquiry was carried out. He submits that after the enquiry conducted, no substance was found in the complaints. It is also submitted that one FIR No.21 dated 13.01.2021 under Sections 406/506 IPC was registered at Police Station Jind against the petitioner and he was arrested as well. He submits that in view of the status report, prayer made by

the petitioner has been complied with and no substance was found in the complaints filed.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedy in accordance with law.
