KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw his power of attorney on behalf of the petitioner.

Request is allowed.

State counsel on instructions from ESI Balram apprised the Court that initially, petitioner-Mohit Nayyar joined the investigation but on the last date of hearing, the petitioner was given specific directions by this Court to join further investigation with the police on 10.3.2023 and 27.3.2023 but he failed to comply with the said orders.

Ms. Meenakshi Vats, Authorised Officer appearing on behalf of the bank submits that as per her instructions, now Mohit Nayyar is

absconding.

In view of above, as petitioner-Mohit Nayyar failed to comply with previous order and is not cooperating with the police any more, the petitioner is not entitled to grant of discretionary relief of anticipatory bail in the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, the present petition is hereby dismissed and order of interim bail dated 12.5.2022 is hereby vacated.
