1. Petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to regularize her services as per Policy Instructions dated 04.03.1999 and 15.12.2006 (Annexures P-2 and P-5, respectively) and as per judgment dated 15.03.2004 passed in CWP-16655-2003 (Annexure P-3) and further to extend the benefit of judgment dated 27.07.2018 (Annexure P-8).
2. Learned counsel for the respondents while referring to Annexure P-14 submits that services of the petitioner has already been terminated vide order dated 28.02.2022 and she has also received the compensation amount of Rs.19,800/- and nothing remains for adjudication in the present petition.
3. The above fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the

petitioner.

4. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed.
