VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ of certiorari for setting aside impugned orders dated 19.04.2022 and 20.09.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-4) passed by the Maintenance Tribunal (Sub-Divisional Magistrate), Talwandi Sabo.

2. A perusal of the order dated 20.09.2022 would show that it has been recorded that during the course of hearing, the petitioner had submitted that she has no objection to pay maintenance to the respondent in case the respondent himself appeared in the Court. It has further been observed that on 13.09.2022, the respondent had himself appeared in the Court and claimed maintenance from the petitioner at his own free will and had reiterated his claim for maintenance.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
