The grievance of the petitioner is that the 'No Objection Certificate' is not being issued to her and they are insisting upon depositing of non-construction charges, which the petitioner is not liable to pay. Reasons and the details have been given by the petitioner in her representations which have been submitted by her on 12.11.2021 and 18.11.2021 (Annexure P-9 to P-9-B). The said representations till date have not been decided nor any response has been received in pursuance thereto.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G.Jauhar, Addl.AG., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In the light of the grievance as has been highlighted by the petitioner in the writ petition, we, without commenting upon the merits of the case or commenting therein, dispose of the present writ petition by directing the Estate

Officer, Greater Mohali Area Development Authority, Mohali-respondent no.2, to consider and take a decision on the representations as submitted by the petitioner Annexures P-9 to P-9-B within a period of four weeks in the light of the accompanying communication dated 07.01.2020, Annexure P-6. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith and in case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits thereof be given to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.
