The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing police protection to the petitioners and further direction to respondent No.3 not to interfere and not to let respondent Nos.4 to 8 or anybody else to interfere with the liberty and lives of petitioners or harass them in any manner against their wishes and to their detriment by using force on them or by adopting unlawful means and from implicating the petitioners and the family members of petitioner No.1 in a false and frivolous criminal case.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners on 27.11.2019 and 30.08.2022 and even today also, none is present on behalf of the petitioners.

In pursuance of the notice of motion the reply by way of affidavit of Ravinder Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sirsa has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 wherein it has been stated

that statement of petitioner No.1 Jasvinder Kaur (minor) was recorded under Section 164 Cr.PC before the Ld. Duty Magistrate, Sirsa on 10.05.2018 wherein she stated that she alone has gone at Amritsar from her house where she stayed in a gurudwara and she had gone without informing her family and thereafter she has returned back to her house and at present residing with her family. She further stated that she had gone with her own free will and also returned with her own will and she never joined the company of the petitioner No.2 nor she ever intended to file the petition seeking protection from her family members and she is still residing with her mother and her family at village Maujain and she is having no apprehension from her family in any manner whatsoever.

In view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
