AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This is a petition under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short, 'the Act') for appointment of an arbitrator for adjudication of disputes between the parties.
2. The petitioner was allotted tender for manufacture, testing and supply of multi core, LT, XLPE Cables. There was a supply agreement between the parties. Clause 25 of the general terms and conditions provides for dispute resolution through arbitration. Clause 24 provides that all legal proceedings shall be subject to territorial jurisdiction at Patiala.
3. The petitioner served notice dated 17.1.2022. On failure to do the needful, the present petition was filed.
4. Learned counsel for the parties agree to the appointment of Mr. Navdeep Sharma, Advocate, Patiala as sole arbitrator.
5. The petition is accordingly disposed of by appointing Mr. Navdeep Sharma, Advocate, Chamber No. 217, First Floor, Yadvendra Complex, District Court, Patiala as the sole arbitrator. The arbitrator is appointed subject to declaration to be made by him under Section 12 of the Act with regard to his independence and impartiality to settle the dispute
