MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.29 dated 11.01.2023 under Sections 21B of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and sections 186, 332, 341, 353, 427 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.10.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions submits that the

petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for her custodial interrogation.

4. On a pointed query put to the learned State counsel as to what was the role attributed to the petitioner and how did her name surface in the case in hand, he, on instructions, submits that when the son of the petitioner was nabbed along with 43.70 grams of Heroin, the petitioner and others tried to come in the way of the police and pelted stones at the police party. On a further pointed query put to the learned State counsel as to whether the petitioner has any criminal antecedents, he on instructions has replied in the negative.

5. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 10.10.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to her, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to her.
