VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the case bearing FIR No.216 dated 28.11.2019, under Sections 307/148/149 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Chattiwind, Amritsar.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Iqbal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Crime Against Women & Children), Amritsar (Rural), on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition and restricts his prayer only to the extent that the petitioner shall surrender before the learned Illaqa Magistrate within a period of 10 days and application of regular bail which may be moved by him be directed to be disposed of expeditiously.
4. The present petition is disposed of. However, it is directed that in the event, the petitioner surrenders within a period of 10 days and on conclusion of police remand, if any, an application for regular bail is moved, the Court seized of the matter may look into the feasibility of expeditious disposal therein, in accordance with law.
