Main cases

1. The aforementioned appeals arising out of a common award, are thus being decided together.
2. Challenge in the first 2 appeals are to the Award dated 10.01.1997 passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Patiala (for short ‘the Tribunal’) vide which a sum of Rs.4,55,000/- & Rs. 1,13,000/- alongwith interest @ 12% per annum, had been awarded to the claimant-respondents and the appellant is held liable to pay the said amount and in the 3rd appeal is for enhancement of compensation.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant had sought time to ascertain as to whether any objections were filed within two months by either parties against the proposed order dated 14.02.2001 passed by Lok Adalat enhancing the compensation to Rs.1,63,200/- or was it accepted and implemented. He submits that though there was a communication dated 11.03.2021 addressed to the learned counsel representing the appellant at that time for filing the objections, however, neither is there any record available of those nor of any order passed thereon.
4. In view of the above, all appeals stand disposed of as per the proposed award of the Lok Adalat.
5. Copy of the order be sent to the concerned Tribunal for compliance.
6. Photocopy of the same be placed on the files of connected cases.
