1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is working since 1986 but his services have not been regularized and that too without any valid justification, hence, respondents are under obligation to consider the claim of the petitioner to regularize his services.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that claim of a candidate for regularization of his/her services can only be undertaken under a Policy issued by the Government. Learned counsel further submits that the latest Policy, which was issued on 18.06.2014, has already been set-aside by this Court in ***CWP No.17206 of 2014 titled as Yogesh Tyagi and another vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on***

31.05.2018 though the said issue is pending consideration before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the judgment by which the Policy dated 18.06.2014 was quashed, is still pending consideration before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh one or to revive the present petition in case any right subsists with the petitioner after the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to claim regularization.
