The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 04.02.2020/12.02.2020 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur.

Status report dated 03.04.2022 by way of an affidavit of Sh.Sandeep Singh Mand, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira, District Ferozepur has already been filed in the Registry which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has already given specific affidavit before the police to the effect that he does not want to further pursue the present case and he has no objection if the petition filed by him before this Court is disposed of as challan has already been presented before the trial Court.
