Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is to direct the respondents to grant some time to the petitioner to pay the overdue installments alongwith interest and to take a decision on the application of the petitioners dated 02.03.2013 (Annexure P-4).

Mr. Gupta submits that the matter has been settled in as much as the One Time Settlement has been entered into.

Mr. Chandeeep Singh, Advocate has filed Memo of Appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-Bank and has placed on record the terms and conditions of the OTS dated 14.03.2023 wherein, a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- has already been received against the 10% initial upfront under the Rinn Samadhan 2022-23 Scheme. The remaining amount of Rs.7,30,177/- is now due.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is disposed of by binding down the parties to the Scheme as such. Needless to say in case there is any default, it is open to the bank to proceed afresh against the petitioner.
