The petitioner has filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) to the Station House Officer, Gurugram and he shall be satisfied in case an appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3 to look into her representation dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-2).

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Kumar, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.3 – Station House

officer to look into the matter and take appropriate action as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.
