KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. On 21.03.2023, at the time of issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that after securing bail the petitioner has been regularly appearing in his trial but could not appear only on 24.11.2022; such non-appearance was on account of a communication gap between him and his counsel appearing for him before the trial court and that the petitioner undertakes to appear on all dates in his trial in the future unless specifically exempted.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Arun Luthra, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and prays for time to argue the matter.

Adjourned to 18.05.2023.

In the meanwhile, subject to the petitioner appearing before the trial court within a week from today he shall be admitted to interim bail to the trial court's satisfaction”.

2. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record an order dated 29.03.2023 passed by the learned JMIC, depicting therein that petitioner had caused appearance and furnished bail bonds before the learned

Magistrate concerned, on 27.03.2023, and that the petitioner is regularly appearing before the learned trial Court concerned. Though, the instant petition is for quashing of order dated 24.11.2022, vide which the bail of the petitioner has been cancelled, however, the counsel for the petitioner is unable to point out any illegality or infirmity in the impugned order. Therefore, the impugned order is hereby affirmed, however, considering the fact that the petitioner, in compliance of the order dated 29.03.2023 (supra), had caused appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, therefore, no further interference is required.

4. The instant petition is disposed of accordingly.
