SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to pay the salary from August 2018 from the date when the respondent No.4 has taken over the contract of providing services of Chowkidars at Micro Hydel Project, HPGCL, Kakroi, District Sonipat.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondents to look into the legal notice dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-3), within a time bound manner.

3. Learned counsel for respondents has not opposed the prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner and submits that the legal notice dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-3) shall be considered and decided in accordance with law within a period of two months from today.

4. Without adverting to the merits of the case, respondents are directed to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
5. A copy of order so passed, be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.
6. The petition is disposed of.
