Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.126 dated 02.03.2022, under Sections 354-A, 354-B, 376, 506, 511 of IPC and Sections 10, 18, 6 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars since 04.03.2022. However, learned State counsel at the outset, on instructions from Inspector Savit Kumar, submits that in all there are 23 prosecution witnesses, out of which, 21 witnesses already stand examined and only 02 witnesses remain to be examined. He further submits that the next date fixed before the trial Court for examining the evidence of remaining witnesses is 23.03.2023.

After hearing the submissions made by learned State counsel, this Court do not find it appropriate to go into the merits of the case

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keeping in view the status of the trial. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial.
