The petitioner complains of non-release of his retiral benefits, on account of the pendency of the disciplinary proceedings, in which an inquiry report has already been submitted by the enquiry officer.

Learned State counsel, who has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents, on instructions from Sh.Bhagat Singh, Superintendent, Education, submits that out of the retiral benefits, the component of GPF as well as GIS have already been released to the petitioner and matter with regard to the payment of pension, gratuity and leave encashment has been recommended to the competent authority, which is likely to decide the claim within a short time.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Principal Secretary, Department of Health, Punjab, to take a decision on the matter, within a period of 15 days, from today, positively.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
