The prayer in the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for issuing directions to respondent no.2 & 3 to release the petitioner forthwith in view of the order passed by Punjab Government for Premature Release dated 02.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) with a further prayer for seeking directions to the respondent no.3 to release the petitioner on personal bonds in view of the Govt. Policy dated 19.06.2017 (Annexure P-2).

When this matter came up for hearing on 30.03.2022 it was adjourned on request for 04.04.2022 on which date notice of motion was issued. Subsequently, a reply was filed by Iqbal Singh Dhaliwal, PPS, Superintendent New District Jail, Nabha. As per the said reply the petitioner has been released from the jail on 29.04.2022 after execution of

the required two bonds of Rs.30,000/- each.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
