This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to take legal action against respondent Nos.8 and 9 for misusing the public funds.

On 17.03.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-
