By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to proceed with and to inquire into the allegations levelled by the petitioner in his complaint dated 14.04.2022.

In response to the notice of motion, a short reply by way of affidavit of Sukhwant Singh Gill, IPS, Assistant Inspector General of Police, Internal Vigilance Cell, Punjab, Chandigarh on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the stand taken by respondent-State, the inquiry upon the complaint submitted by the petitioner has been concluded and nothing incriminating has been found against any of the officials.

In view thereof, nothing survives to be adjudicated upon in the present case as the representation submitted by the petitioner already stands inquired into. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, respondent-State shall forward a copy of the inquiry report based on the complaint submitted by the petitioner to him within a period of two weeks from today.
