JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is seeking direction to respondents to initiate extradition process against Williamjit Singh i.e. husband of the petitioner in FIR No.65 dated 29.03.2016, under Sections 498A, 406 and 34 of IPC, 1860 registered at Phagwara City, District Kapurthala.
2. Learned State counsel submits that Williamjit Singh has already been declared proclaimed person. LOC stands issued and petitioner is at liberty to move Ministry of External Affairs or Home Ministry for redressal of her grievance.
3. On being confronted with afore-stated facts, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is time and again approaching Ministry of External Affairs as well as Home Ministry and she may be granted liberty to avail remedies as permissible by law.
4. Disposed of with liberty to petitioner to avail remedies as permissible by law.
