Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.125 dated 10.12.2022, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

On 16.03.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that though as per allegations levelled in FIR, injury on the right finger of the injured has been attributed to the petitioner, however, on comparison of the contents of FIR with the MLR there is no such injury mentioned in the medico-legal report.

Notice of motion for 28.03.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will join investigation before the Investigating Officer as and when called. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashwani Kumar, submits that in compliance of aforesaid order dated 16.03.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further interrogation.

Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed. Order dated 16.03.2023 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.
