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**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider the petitioner for the post of Constable (General Duty) under Sports Quota 2020-2021 in the Board Security Force.

2. The petitioner pursuant to advertisement dated 23.07.2021 (Annexure P-11) applied for the post of Constable (General Duty) under Sports Quota. The petitioner was initially found medically unfit, however, in the Review Medical Board, she was found medically fit.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there were 10 posts meant for sports quota and 6 candidates have been selected, thus, case of the petitioner can be considered.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents pointing out page 32 of the paper-book submits that petitioner applied under 57 kg free style

category and there was only one post in the said category. One candidate has already been selected against said category, thus, claim of the petitioner cannot be considered.

5. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to challenge the selection on merits.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
