Prayer in this application is for placing on record the online zimni orders Annexures P-11 to P-14 and for exemption from filing certified copies thereof.

Heard. For the reasons, mentioned in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Zimni Orders Annexures P-11 to P-14 are taken on record.

Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 02.11.2022 (Annexure P-10), passed by learned Sessions Judge, Faridabad, vide which the bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled and warrants of arrest were issued against her.

Without going into the merits of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is willing to settle the matter and shall submit to the jurisdiction of the Court on the date fixed i.e. 27.03.2023. Learned counsel further submits that on appearance, the petitioner shall deposit Rs.5,00,000/- with the Appellate Court to show her bonafides which may eventually be paid to the complainant as per the discretion of the Court. He submits that the only apprehension of the petitioner is that the moment the petitioner appears before the Appellate Court, she shall be taken into custody.

Keeping in view the very fair submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the Appellate Court on or before 27.03.2023 and deposits a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- with the Appellate Court towards her liability, she shall be released on bail.

Needless to say that the petitioner will keep on regularly appearing before the Appellate Court and in case of any further violation, the Appellate Court shall be free to adopt the procedure as envisaged under law.
