Latest report by way of affidavit of Shri Gurvinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, NRI Wing, Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1, 2 and 4, as per which, petitioner's father had earlier executed an agreement dated 06.11.2012 in favour of the present petitioner but later on, he disinherited the petitioner and his brother by publishing a notice dated 02.05.2013 in Ajit Newspaper. Petitioner's father later on bequeathed the said property in the name of respondent No.5 vide registered Will dated 27.05.2014 and thus it was found during the enquiry that the matter is of civil nature and no police action was warranted.

In view of the afore-said report submitted by the Police, this petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the other remedies available to him under law, in case he is not satisfied with the report.
