Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.257 dated 25.11.2020 under Sections 302/307/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

The learned State counsel has filed status report dated 05.01.2023 by way of an affidavit of Sh. Sarbjit Rai, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Adampur, District Jalandhar (Rural), on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record. It has been stated in para 5 of the status report that the petitioner has been found innocent in the present FIR and the said report reads as under:-

“5. That it is respectfully submitted that as per the order dated 28.09.2022 the State was directed to file fresh status report. That the above said order was received in the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) and the same was marked to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Adampur, i.e. the deponent for filing the status report as per the further investigation in FIR No.257 (supra). That during the course of further investigation a report having No.1777/R.DSP dated 04.01.2023, has been concluded by the deponent and the same has been approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), and thereafter, Zimani No.94 dated 29.12.2022 has been recorded, whereby, it has been found that no involvement of Tanvir Singh alias Tanna son of Paramjit Singh, resident of village Jandu Singha, Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar has come on record till date and he is innocent in the FIR in question. That the copy of the report of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Adampur i.e. The deponent is annexed herewith that Annexure R-1/T. ”

Vide order dated 13.09.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 13.09.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 13.09.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
