Present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 3.2.2023 (Annexure P-2) whereby the learned trial Court has cancelled the bail order and gave direction to summon the petitioner through non-bailable warrants of arrest on account of his absence before the said Court on that date.

The counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the absence of the petitioner on the relevant date was not intentional and further submits that at the relevant time, wife of the petitioner was not well and on account of her illness, the petitioner failed to appear in the Court concerned and later on she was operated upon in Apollo Hospital and that the

concerned medical treatment record of the wife of the petitioner is Annexure P-2 (collectively). The counsel further submits that this was first default on the part of the petitioner and the petitioner is ready to join proceedings before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. A.M. Punchi, Addl. P.P., accepts notice on behalf of UT Chandigarh and apprised that the petitioner jumped bail on 3.2.2023 and resultantly impugned order was passed by the learned trial Court.

In view of the above in order to avoid delay in trial proceedings, the petitioner is hereby directed to appear before the trial Court within next 20 days and on his doing so, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction. However, the petitioner is directed to remain careful in future and to appear before the Court concerned on each and every date fixed in the trial.
